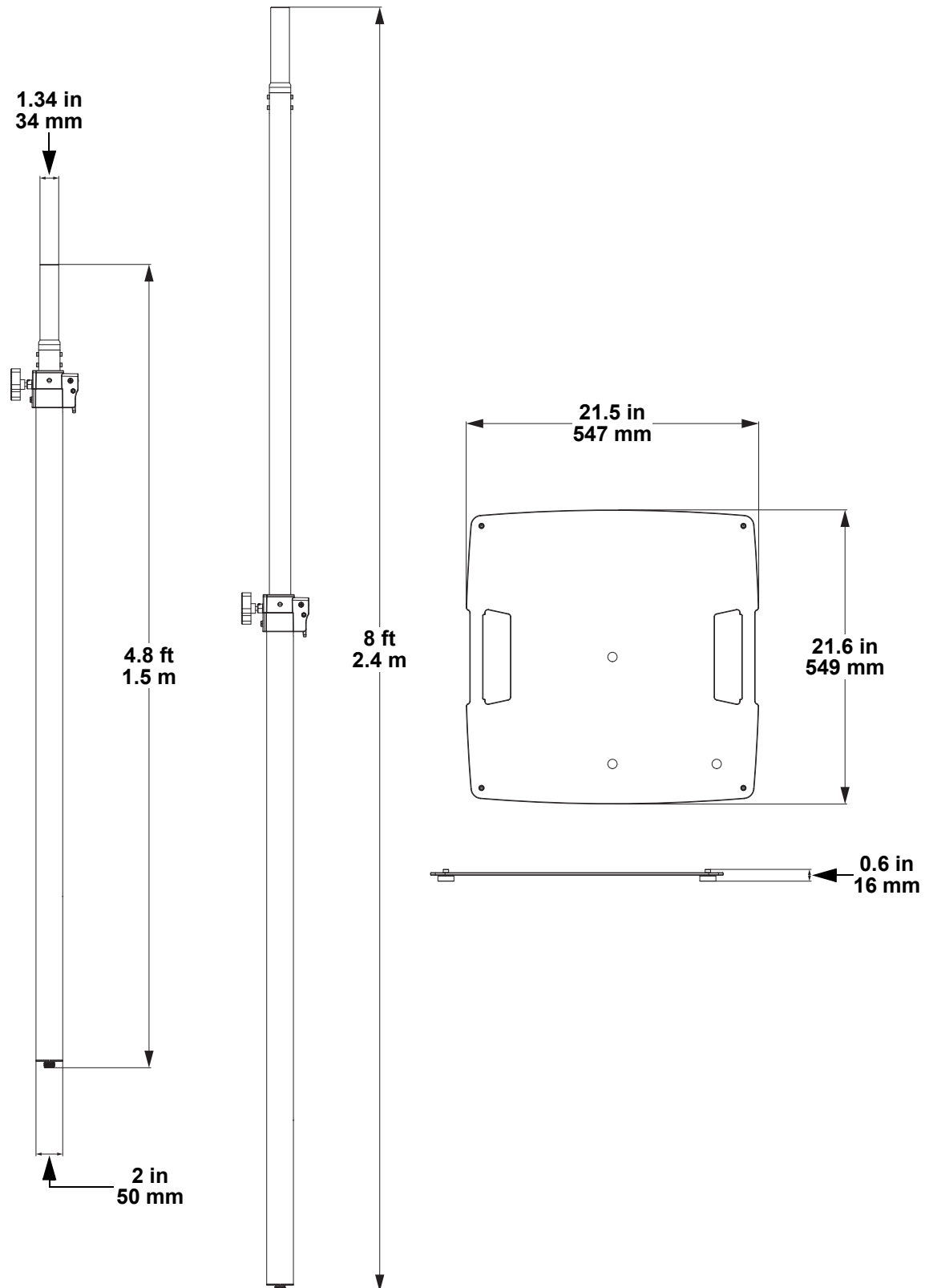

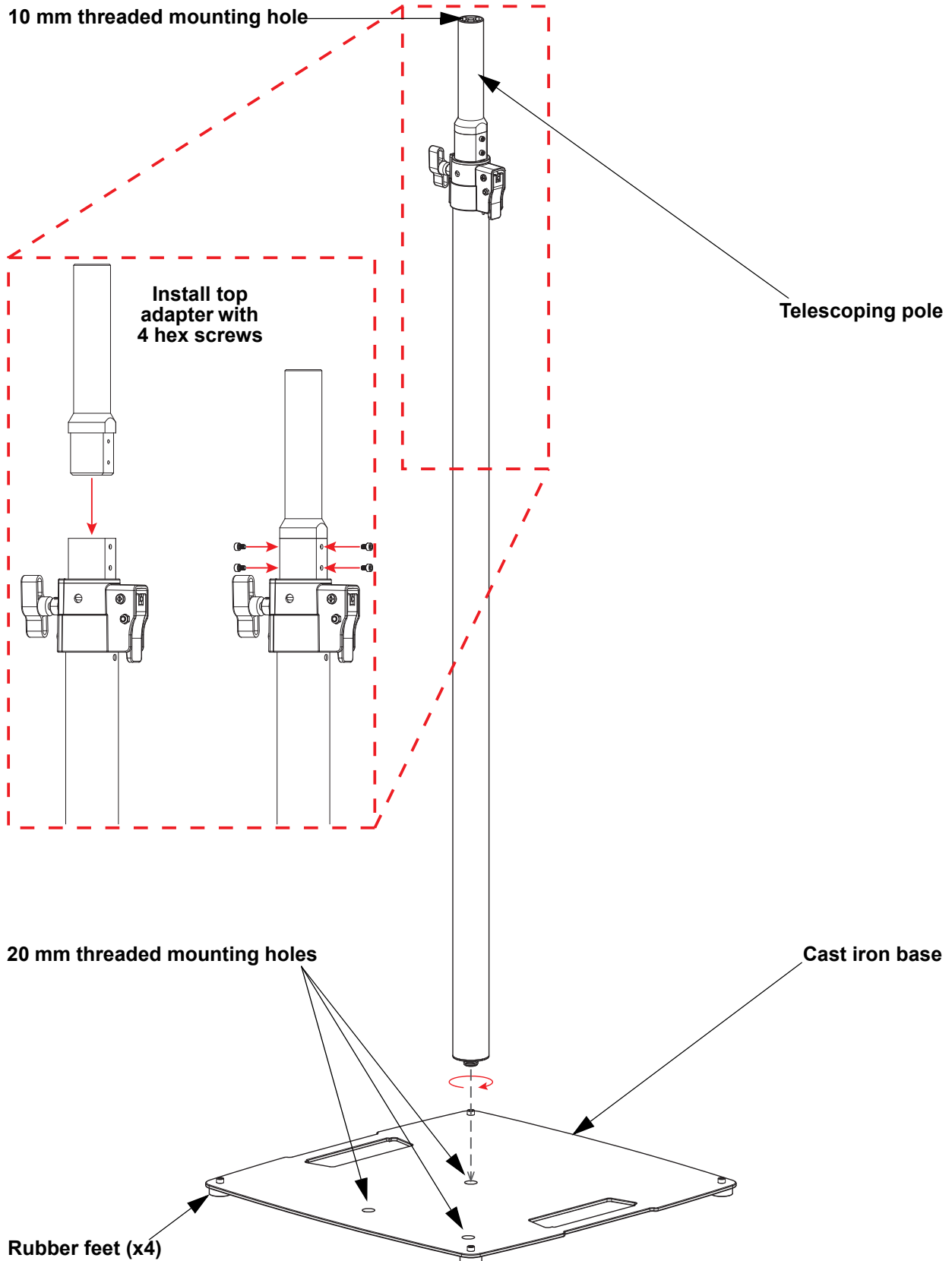

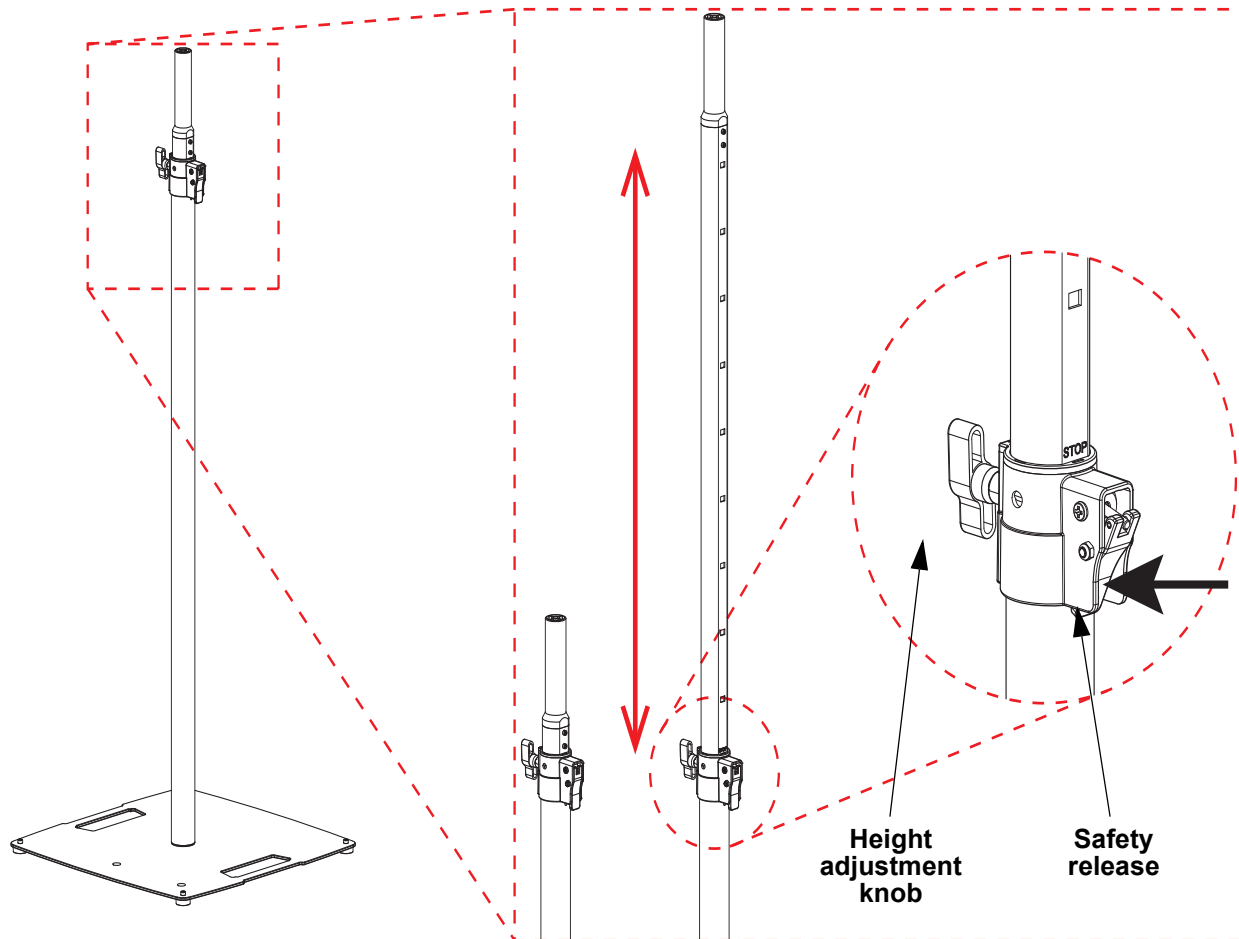
Telescoping Pole

To increase the height of the telescoping pole:

1. Loosen the height adjustment knob.
2. Adjust until the safety release clicks into place at the desired height.
3. Tighten the height adjustment knob.

To decrease the height of the telescoping pole:

1. Loosen the height adjustment knob.
2. Press in and hold the safety release.
3. Adjust to the desired height and let go of the safety release.
4. Adjust until the safety release clicks into place.
5. Tighten the height adjustment knob.

Product Maintenance

To maintain optimum performance and minimize wear, clean all products at least twice a month. However, be aware that usage and environmental conditions could be contributing factors to increase the cleaning frequency.

To clean the product, use a vacuum (or dry compressed air) and a soft brush to remove dust collected on the external surface.
